



## COVID-19 Event Protocol – Haunted Hunt

Due to the 2019-2020 outbreak of the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), National Service Dogs is taking extra precautions with the care of participants, volunteers and staff at our events. In compliance with Government guidelines all events will be outside and restricted to 100 or fewer people; including staff and volunteers.

Staff, Volunteers and Participants will be required to wear masks and maintain a 6' social distance. NSD will have hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes and masks on hand at all times during the event.

Registration/Check In and Prize Pick Up tables will be appropriately spaced to create safe distances and the tables will be disinfected regularly throughout the event. These areas will also be set up in such a way as to ensure that participants leaving the tables will flow in a designated direction in order to limit face to face contact. Appropriate signage will be in place to help manage the people flow.

During Registration/Check In and Prize Pick Up all staff and volunteers will be masked at all times. Participants are asked to select one (1) family member to complete the Registration/Check In and Prize Pick Up in order to reduce the number of people gathering at the tables. Any participants directly interacting with staff or volunteers must be wearing a mask. Staff and volunteers will sanitize their hands after interacting with each participant at the Registration/Check In and Prize Pick Up Areas and Participants will be asked to sanitize their hands prior to completing Registration/Check In and Prize Pick Up.

Staff and volunteers will be available to monitor the Hunt Space to ensure that appropriate distancing is maintained by participants throughout the event. COVID19 Health Information Posters issued by the Public Health Agency of Canada will be posted on site.

The attached health attestation form must be completed and signed by all individual participants or at least one family member on the day of the event. This information will enable NSD to contact trace if necessary. The information will be kept private, confidential and in a secure location once it is returned to NSD after the event.

# COVID-19 Health Attestation & Liability Release Waiver

Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever
- Fatigue
- Dry Cough
- Difficulty Breathing
- Gastrointestinal Symptoms
- Loss of Sense of Smell or Taste

- I/We I affirm that I, as well as all household members, have not traveled outside of the country or to any city considered to be a “hot spot” for COVID-19 infections within the past 30 days.
- I/We I understand that National Service Dog Training Centre Inc. cannot be held liable for any exposure to the COVID-19 virus caused by misinformation on this form or the health history provided by each visitor.

By signing below, I agree to each statement above. I acknowledge and accept that there is a risk that I could be exposed to COVID-19 while attending this event. I agree to release the NSD, their officers, directors, employees, agents and volunteers (the “Releasees”) from any and all causes of action, claims, demands, requests, damages or any recourse whatsoever in respect of any personal injuries or other damages which may occur or arise as a result of exposure to COVID-19 during my participation in this event.
